Eric wants us at Meadow Brook Church to know how thankful he and Julia are for our prayers for the Uncover McGill events that took place in January.

The following paragraph will explain why he and Julia are so encouraged: "There were about 1400 students who came to the 15 events. Some of these were people who came to a number of different lectures. It was very encouraging to meet students who were very sceptical, even hostile, at the beginning of the week yet who became very open to considering God and reading the Bible by the end of the week. This is due to God working through your prayers and the quality of the speakers."

One person that Eric is particularly encouraged about is Scott. Scott became a Christian during Uncover McGill in 2017. He continued to be involved with P2C (Power to Change) this year and was one of the volunteer organizers for this year's event. For the next 2 months he is helping to lead an Alpha study for those students who are seeking and asking questions. Of the 7 students in Scott's Alpha group, Eric feels that 3 of them have already become Christians! We are part of this story because we pray for the Roses' ministry on campus and because of our financial support.

Eric would like us to pray for;

1. Scott's Alpha group- for salvation for those who have not yet made a decision for Christ and for growth for the new believers.
2. From March 7-9 Eric will take 7- 10 students to Queens University in Kingston during the McGill reading week to help and encourage the Queens University students in their work on their campus. Please pray that the Lord will work in and through these students.
3. During the months of March and April, the P2C staff will be continuing their discipleship and training of students, along with smaller outreaches on campus and challenging students to lead next fall.

It is definitely a privilege for us at Meadow Brook to be involved in this exciting ministry on the campus of McGill University. Let's be praying for the Roses and the ministry the Lord has given them!
