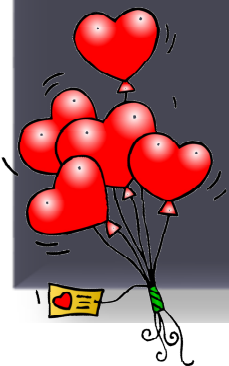

The Lord has been gracious to them as a family, both in terms of providing a wonderful home in a lovely country setting, but also in the friends they've made at church and at school.

There is a Turkish population in Linz where they are able to use their knowledge of the Turkish culture and language to serve these people. Dave travels frequently into Turkey to support ongoing ministries there, and to mentor those he's worked with in the past.

When you pray for the Berg family please remember these items:

Safety for Dave as he travels back and forth to Turkey and to effectively help the young church there. Dave also serves in the local church in Linz.

Language study- Dave has been learning German since they arrived, and Mel has been studying since Christmas. Their son, Josh, who is 10 goes to a local Austrian school which is totally German speaking.

Their daughters, Brook and Mikayla travel by tram/train for an hour to get to the international school they attend and they are taught in English.

Please pray for the children as they study and adapt to a different culture.

As always, pray that the Holy Spirit will draw individuals to Himself and that the Bergs can be used by Him to bring many to faith in Jesus as their Saviour.
